## icapital continues to maintain solid performance

A CLOSED-END fund tha invests in undervalued com panies, icapital.biz Bhd ha proven that serious valu investing works on Burs Malaysia by continuing to maintain a solid perform ance last year. Capital Dynamics Asse

Capital Dynamics Asse Management Sdn Bhd (the fund manager of icapital)' managing director Tan Teng Boo said serious investing could produce solid gain even during a global turbu lence and uncertainties.

"For 2008 financial yea (June 1, 2007 to May 31 2008), the net asset value (NAV) jumped 18.80% ever during a period of height ened fears and concern while the Kuala Lumpu Composite Index (KLCI) fel to 5.24%.

"For the financial yea 2007, the NAV of icapita gained 45.43% while the KLCI rose 45.17%," Tan told a media briefing in Kuala Lumpur yesterday.

Tan said as at July 25, 2008 the company has invested in 18 listed firms with Parksor Holdings, Vads Bhd, Petro nas Dagangan Bhd and Fra ser & Neave Holdings Bhc topping the list in terms o unrealised profits.

"As at July 25, 2008, our investments totalled RM137.73 million at coswhile total unrealised gain despite the current decline on Bursa Malaysia, was RM50.9 million, he said. He said the fund still has RM56.9 million cash available for investing as at July 25 2008

On Bursa Malaysia's outlook given the current political situation in Malaysia Tan said the most important factor to monitor was the local and global economy.

"As long as Malaysia does not face a major political calamity, the long-term outlook for Bursa Malaysia will remain positive," he said. — Bernama
